

## Department of Defense 2024 National Disability Employment Awareness Month Poster

**Poster Description:** The Department of Defense (DoD) recognizes National Disability Employment Awareness Month in October. The 2024 DoD commemorative poster consists of a two-toned blue poster background, depicting a room with an open doorway. The upper walls are depicted as dark blue. The floor is depicted as a lighter blue. Centered on the wall is a yellow-green door which is opened into a white-filled inner room. White light reflects out onto the light-blue floor and appears like a walkway to the doorway.

Centered at the poster's top is the observance theme spread across three lines. The theme's first line is in large white capital text and reads, ACCESS. In place of the second 'C' in the word is an image appearing as an open, key-chambered padlock. The second line in the theme is in finer, capitalized blue text on a yellow-green background and reads, TO GOOD JOBS. The theme's third line is in larger, white capitalized text and reads, FOR ALL.

Centered beneath the theme is a yellow-green spacer line. Centered beneath the line is the observance title in smaller, capitalized white text. The title reads, NATIONAL DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT AWARENESS MONTH.

At the poster's bottom left corner are the seals for the Department of Defense and the Defense Equal Opportunity Management Institute (DEOMI). Centered are the seals for the U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Space Force, and U.S. Coast Guard. At the far-right margin is a dark blue symbol depicting a microphone and two quick response codes (QRC). When scanned with a mobile device, the first QRC will open an audio narration with this poster description. The second QRC will direct an individual to DEOMI's website, [www.deomi.mil](http://www.deomi.mil).

Centered above the QRC's is the observance month in capitalized, black text, OCTOBER.
